Legislative Priorities for the 2023 Session

❖ Juvenile Code Updates

1. NCIC updates for CINA cases, amend Iowa Code Section 692.1(7) to add “or children in need of assistance as defined under Chapter 232”.
2. Disestablishment of paternity, amend 232.6 and add “and to establish and disestablish paternity of a child in a Child in Need of Assistance or Termination of Parental Rights proceeding as provided in section 232.93A and New Section 232.93A”.
3. Waiver of Reasonable Efforts, amend Iowa Code Section 232.102A(5) to include the language “outside of those provided in prior child in need of assistance or termination of parental rights matters”.

❖ Make Continuous Sexual Abuse a 70% mandatory minimum offense, update language to conform with recent statutory changes.

❖ Eliminate the lookback period for domestic abuse assault for Enhancement purposes by striking Iowa Code Section 708.2A(6).

- ❖ Eluding enhancement language fix - In Iowa Code Section 321.279(1)(b), (2)(b), and (3)(b) change “subsection” to “section”.
